What parents Need to Know

Where do we go on the First Day of School?

- a. Teachers and all School Staff will be waiting for you at the back of our school near the designated entrance.
 - i. **ELP** will gather at the ELP exterior door.
 - ii. **Kindergarten** will gather at the south parking lot entrance.
 - iii. **Grade One** Students will gather at the North door under the roof by the portable.
 - iv. **Grade Two/Three** students will gather at the North recess entry door.
 - v. **Grade Four/Five** students will gather at the South portable door.
 - vi. **Grade Six** students will gather by the equipment. Mrs. Wirachowsky will escort you around the outside of the playground to the parking lot door.
- b. We encourage all parents to wear a mask on school property especially when social distancing is a challenge
- c. The front doors will be locked to ensure safety for all. Please call the office and a staff member will meet you at the doors should you need access.

Common Safety Practices

- a. Students will be reminded and encouraged to wash hands with soap and water or sanitizer multiple times throughout the day. (before and after recess, library, gym, lunch, and computers)
- b. All students will be encouraged to wear masks (mandatory for grades 4-6) during independent transition times such as washroom breaks.
- c. Students will remain in cohorts for all classes and lunch break.

Hot lunch and Breakfast Programs

What Parents Need to Know

At-Home Learning: Can my child continue learning from home?

- a. What does at-home learning look like
 - i. Teachers will provide a weekly update of activities and/or assignments
 - ii. MHCBE has hired an online teacher to be available to support your child
 - iii. Parents will communicate with the online teacher for support and are responsible to forward completed work.
 - iv. All core subjects must be covered for online learning
 - v. Parents must discuss and confirm the opportunity of online learning with the school administration
